RECEIVE HHS OFFICE OF WOMEN'S OFFICE HEALTH  
FEDERAL GRANT.**

In September 2010 Women's Health Services, Tewa Women United, and Young Women United received a one-year planning grant from the DHHS Office on Women's Health to establish a New Mexico Coalition for a Healthier Community that reflects the diversity of women in the state.

The New Mexico Coalition for a Healthier Community was one of only 16 selected organizations throughout various regions of the United States. The Coalition is based on the New Mexico Governor's Women Health Council.

During the first phase, each coalition will receive \$100,000 to work on two activities: 1) to identify the health condition having the most adverse effect on the health and well-being of these populations in their community and 2) to subsequently develop a strategy plan and implementation plan that will address the health condition.

We're honored to be selected to help determine which chronic health conditions are most prevalent among our female residents, how to address the health needs here, and then improve health outcomes for local families.
